BOIL-IN-A-BAG OMELET

1. Have guests write their names on quart-size zip-lock freezer bags with a permanent marker.
2. Crack two eggs (large or extra large) into the bag (not more than two); shake to combine them.
3. Put out a variety of ingredients such as cheeses, ham, onion, green pepper, tomato, hash browns, salsa, mushrooms, etc.
4. Have each guest add prepared ingredients of choice to his/her bag and shake.
5. Make sure to remove air from bag, then zip it up.
6. Place bags into rolling boiling water for exactly 13 minutes. You can cook 6-8 omelets in a large pot. For more start another pot of boiling water.
7. Open the bags and omelets will roll out easily. Serve with fresh fruit or toast.
