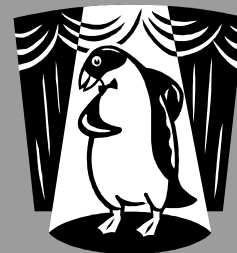

"Prisoner of Second Avenue"



Under the direction of Kathy Fladten, you will laugh and cry during Spotlighters' reprisal of this favorite classic comedy by Neil Simon. It chronicles the lives of a middle-aged couple struggling to survive city life in what was supposed to be a very nice apartment. Instead, they are bombarded with noisy neighbors,

faulty plumbing and loss of employment. This wonderfully funny play takes a grave subject and treats it with hearty, yet sympathetic humor.

Kathy Fladten, who played the upstairs neighbor in Spotlighters' 1978 production of "Prisoner of Second Avenue" knows how to make this play come alive. The outstanding cast consists of lead actors Bill Koslofsky of Chetek as Mel and Meg Atkins of Frederic as Edna and a supporting cast of Mel's brother and sisters consisting of Boyd Stearns of Rice Lake as Harry, Helen Blumer of Cumberland as Pearl, Julie Reid of Rice Lake as Jessie and Kathy Fladten of Barron as Pauline. You will become acquainted with a family in turmoil and you will be able to examine the tensions between family members and men and women - all done in a sympathetic, but humorous way. You may even recognize yourself or one of your family members.

The play runs from Thursday, January 22, 2009 through Saturday, January 24, 2009, Friday and Saturday, January 30 and 31, 2009 and Sunday, February 1, 2009. All performances are at 7:30 p.m. except Sunday, which is at 2:00 p.m. Reserved ticket prices are \$10 for adults and \$8 for children age 14 and under. Tickets are \$1 more at the door.
