Come to the kitchen and laugh to your heart's content at these bumbling, flaming idiots. The show runs from January 21-30.

Just So

The third and final play of the season is a musical that will be marketed to schools as well as to the public. Based on Rudyard Kipling's stories, *Just So* takes you on a fantastic journey along the banks of Africa's great, grey-green Limpopo River to meet an amazing collection of strange and wonderful creatures. Set at the beginning of time, it introduces the Eldest Magician who has created a world of beasts and birds and fish. Everything was just so, until Pau Amma the Crab began playing in the ocean, causing a flood that threatened the other animals. This show will enthrall adults as well as children and should be especially popular with educators. The show runs from April 15-25 with special matinees for school children.
