Youth Summer Theatre Camp

Two weeks to put on a show, but there is so much more to do than just memorize lines.

Yes, at the end of the two weeks we will put on a one act play, but the real fun is *during* the two weeks. In addition to rehearsal, each day will include theatre games and hands-on projects focusing on different elements of community theatre from auditioning and acting to design and production.

- **Get Ready** - shine at auditions, develop acting skills, brainstorm set and costume ideas, promote the show, propose future shows.
- **Set the Stage** - design and build the set, create costumes and props, explore sound effects, build a team that sets a good stage picture.
- **It's Showtime!** - At least 17 speaking parts, and 2 performances.

Anyone who attends camp and is interested in being in the show will be included. Those who don't wish to be in the show, or are unable to attend performances are still welcome to attend camp and be a part of the experience.

Camp is open to students entering 2nd - 8th grade, and activities will be split by age range. Limited space is also available for 1st graders, upon approval.
